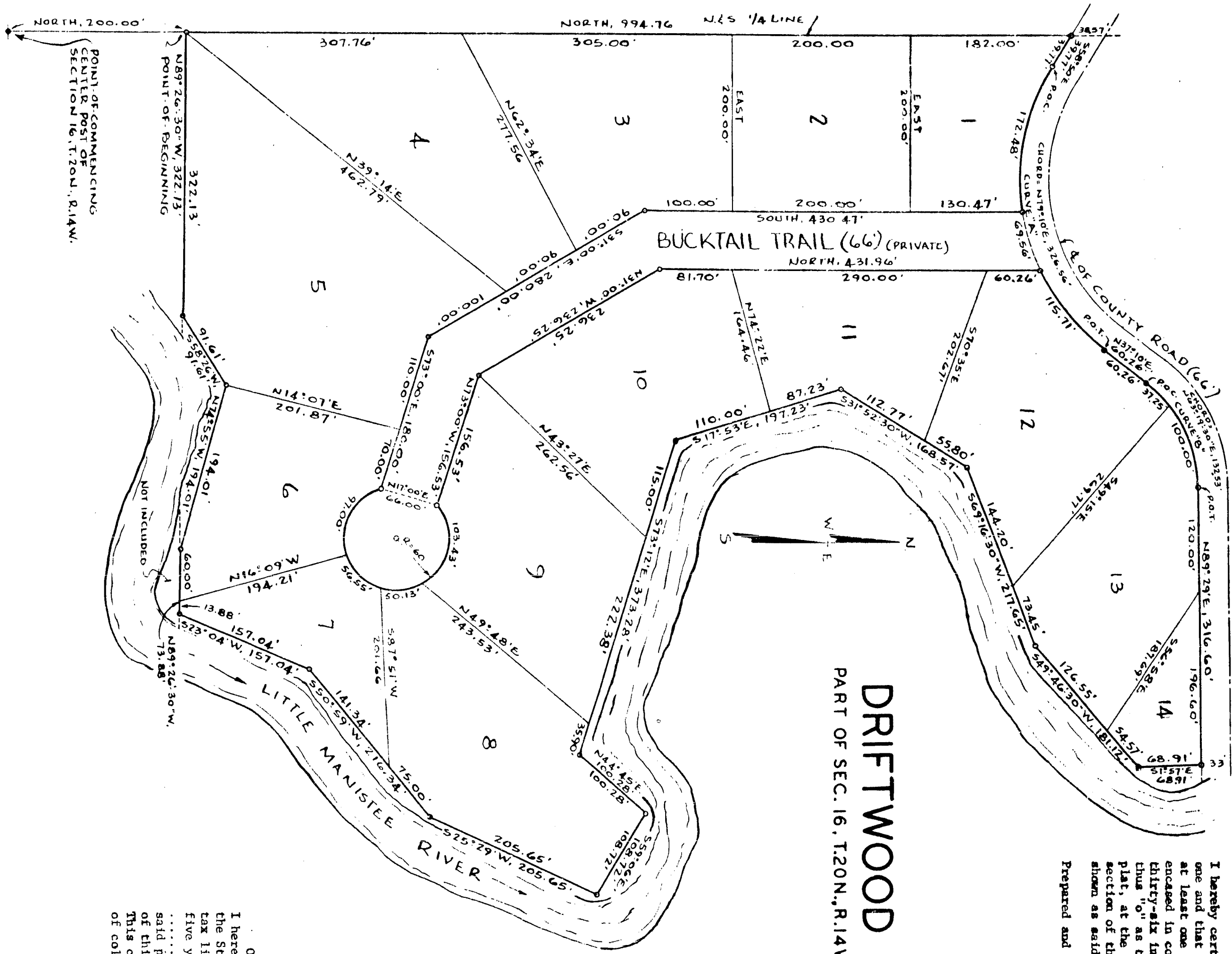


SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of iron rods at least one half inch in diameter and thirty-six inches in length enclosed in concrete cylinders at least four inches in diameter and thirty-six inches in length have been placed at all points marked thus 'o' as thereon shown at all angles in the boundary of the plat, at the intersection of lines of streets, and at the intersection of the lines of streets with the boundaries of the plat as shown as said plat.

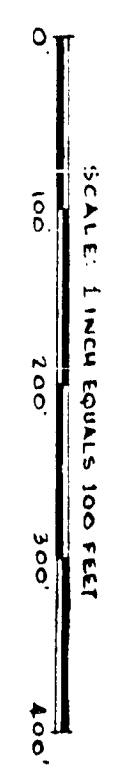
