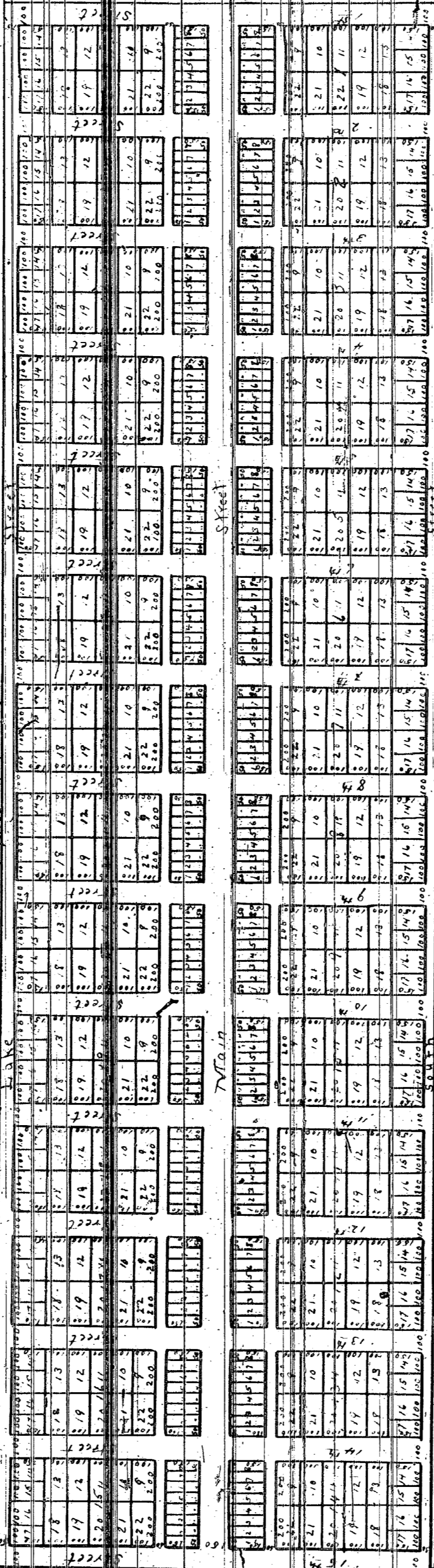


PLAT OF THE VILLAGE OF

Know all men by these presents that I the undersigned have laid out into a village plat the lands above described being on section thirty four in town eighteen north of range thirteen west in Lake County State of Michigan to be known and designated as the Village of Blainville.

The length and width of lots and streets, are given in links by figures on this plat

South Street Marion Street, and Lake Street run parallel with the township line. All other streets run parallel with the section line between Sections 1 and 2.

All streets and Alleys represented on this plat are hereby set apart as public streets and for public use

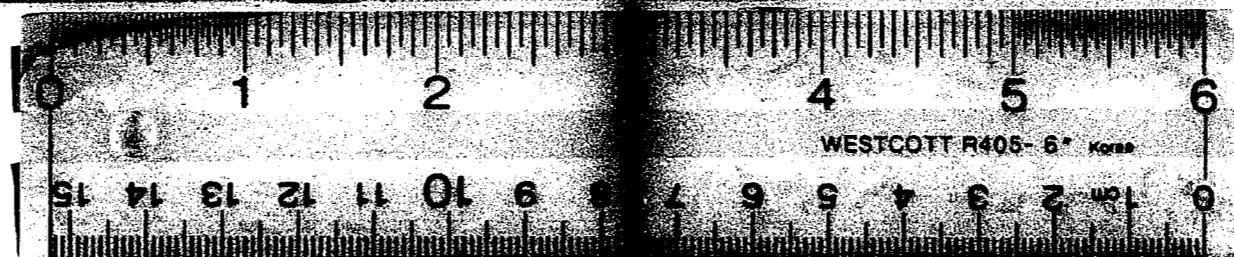
