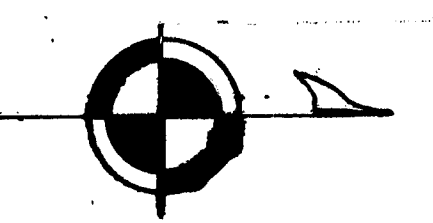

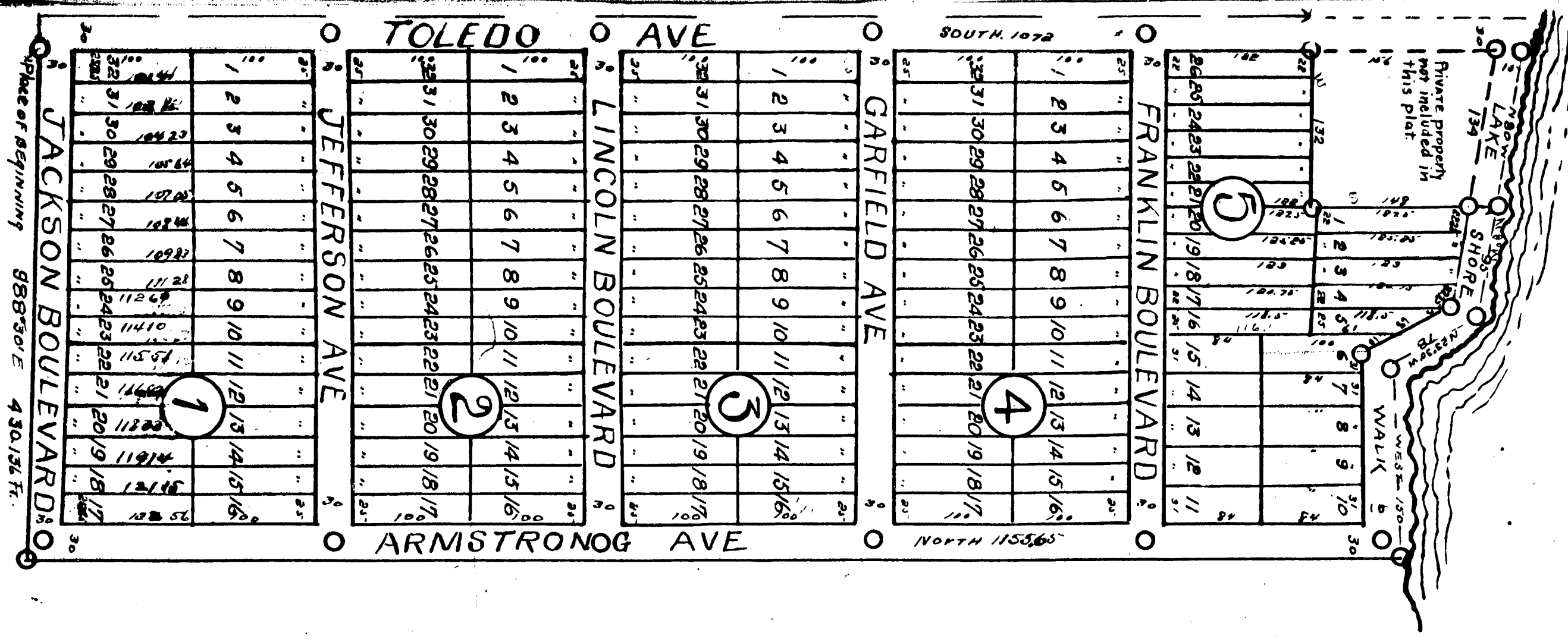
ARMSSTRONG ADDITION

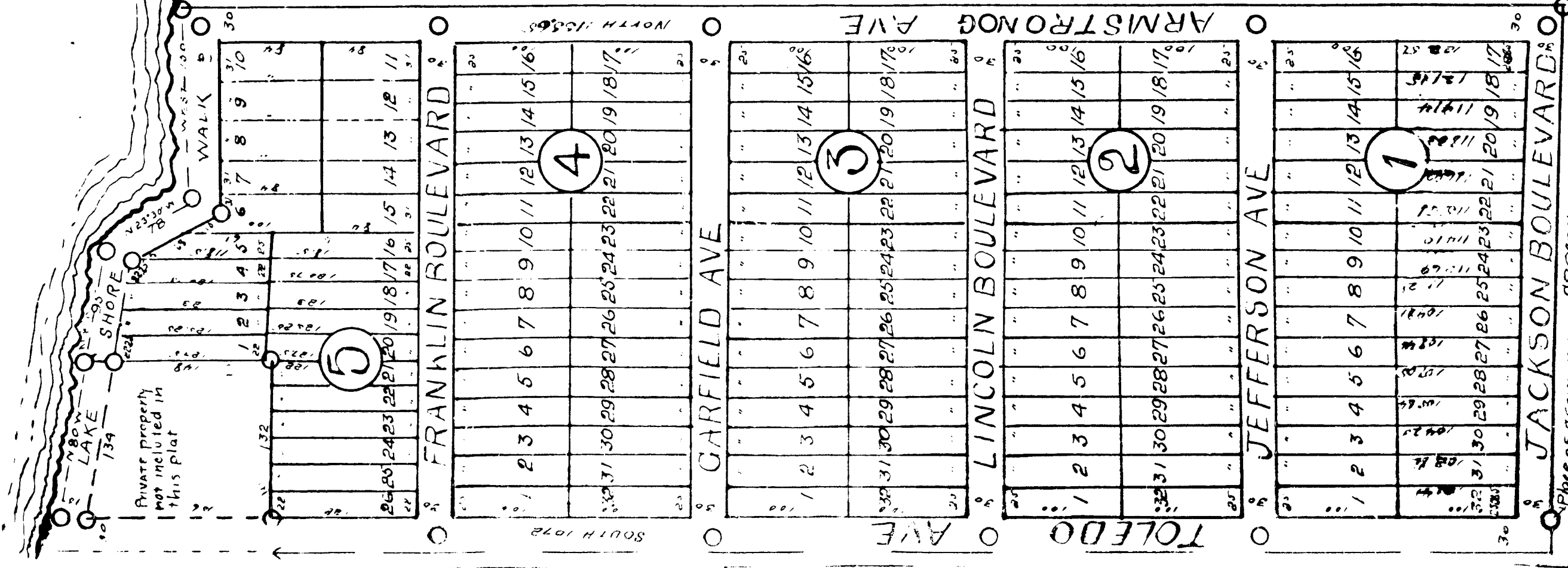
