line of Sec. 30, T30N R13W, with the West line of the Pere Marquette  
Railway Right of Way 112.2 feet West of the 1/4 corner thence S 66° 15'  
E 507.8 feet, thence N 1° E 666 feet thence N 63° 15' E 1632 feet to the  
northernly bank of the Little Maintee River, thence S 10° W  
South easterly along the river bank 242 feet to the river, thence  
Quarter Right of Way thence North 1/4 East thence Northwestly along  
a curve the radius of which is 215 feet, 349 feet thence Northwestly along  
Marquette RR. included in the above description, Right of Way of Pere  
Marquette RR. included in the above description, described as commencing  
at the above described point of beginning, thence North 10° West along a curve  
the radius of which is 215 feet, 100 feet thence South 1/4 along a curve the  
radius of which is 215 feet, 100 feet thence East and West quarter line, thence N. 16° 15' W. 102.3 feet

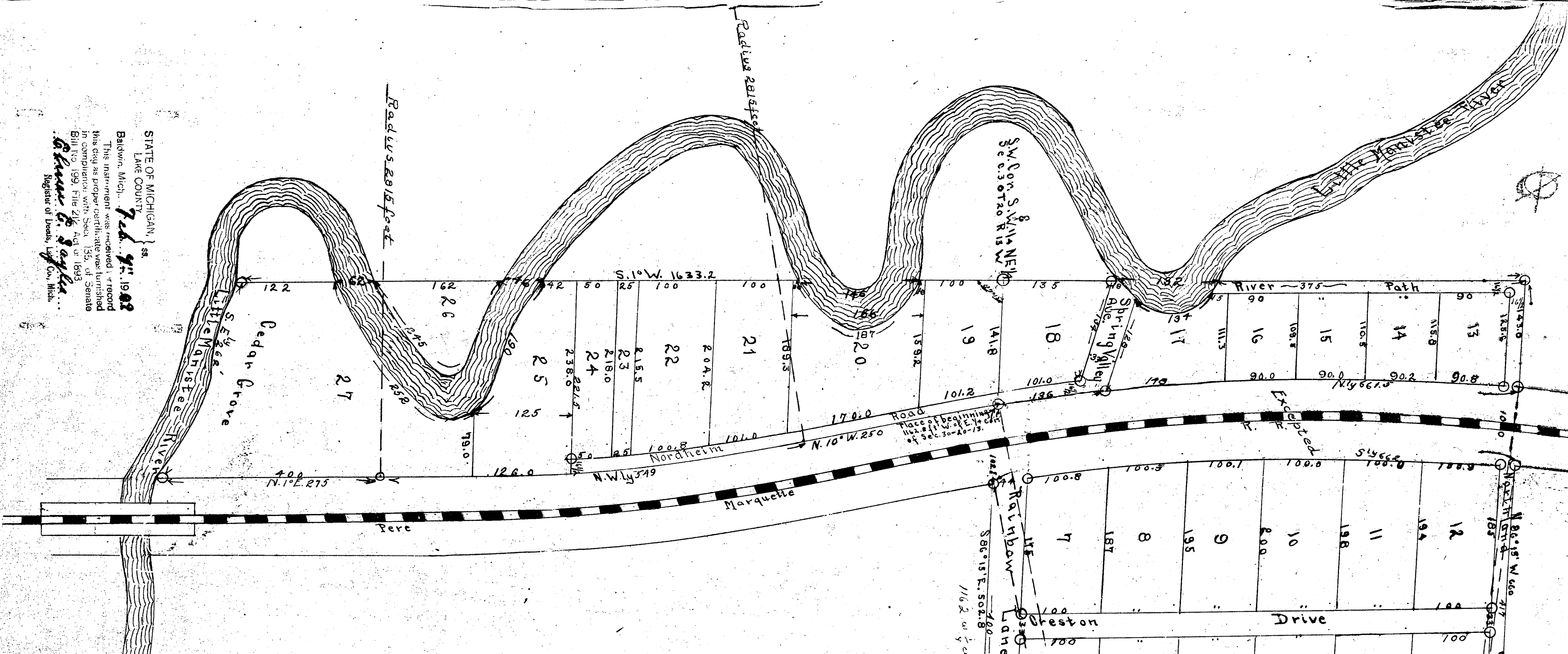
