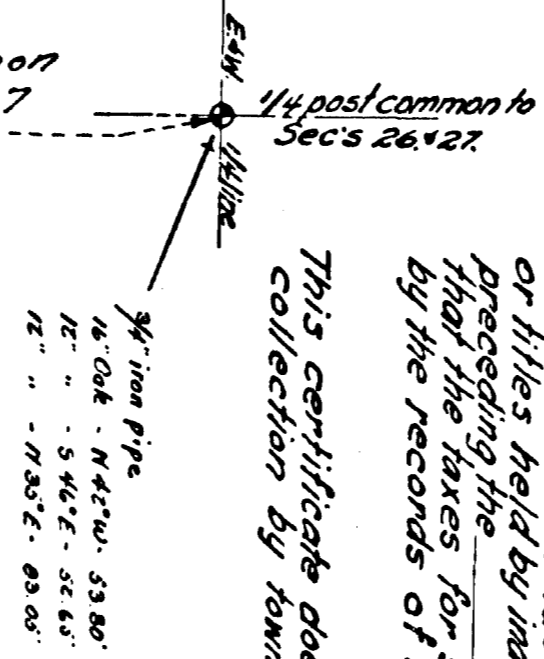
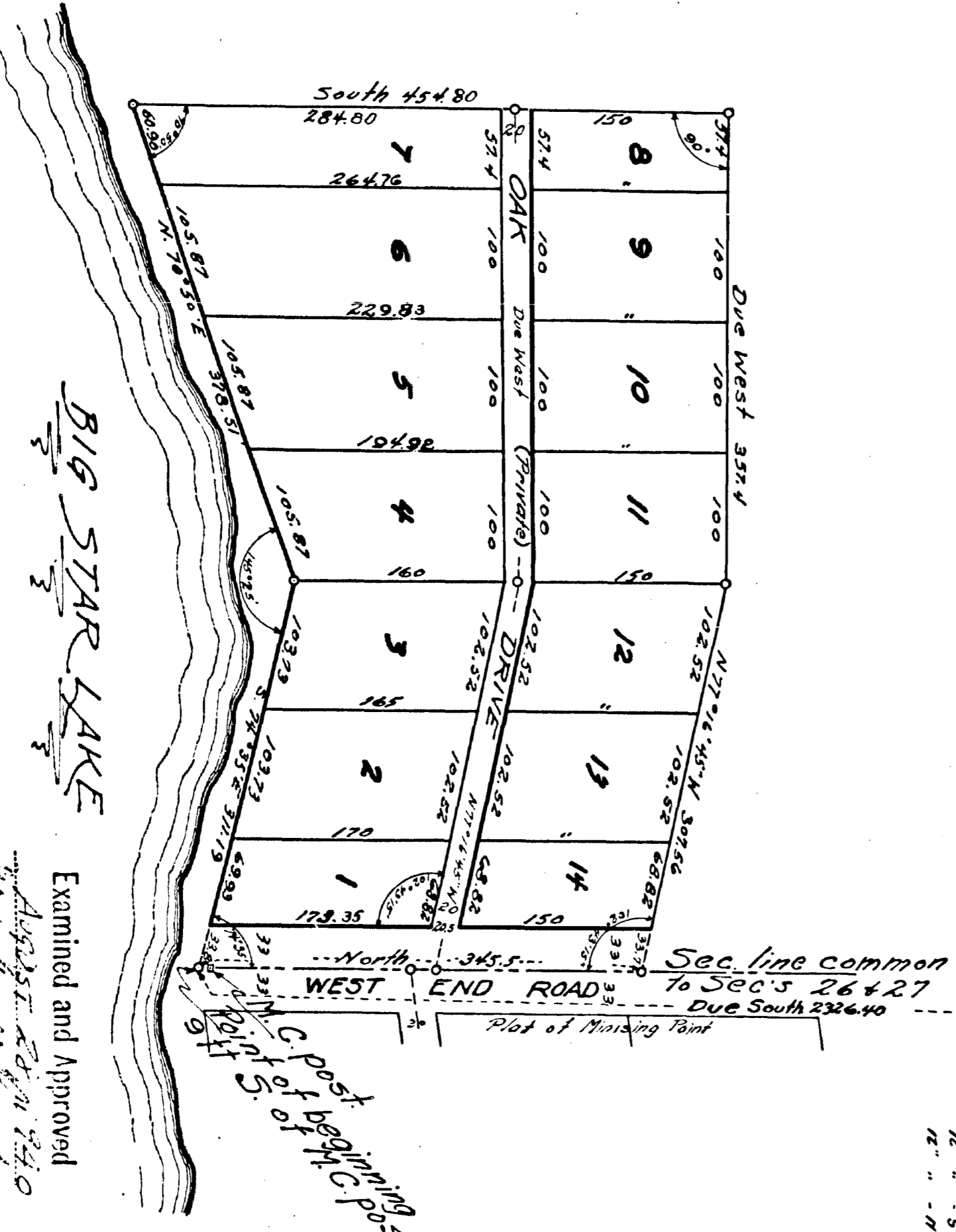
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consist of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 48 inches in length or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches with an over-all length of not less than 48 inches, and attached in a concrete cylinder at least 4 inches in diameter, (O) as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at all the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, and at the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
