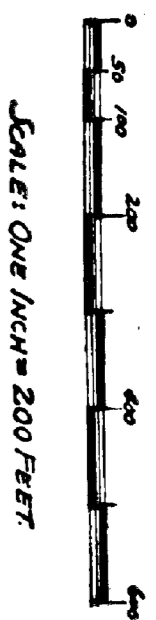
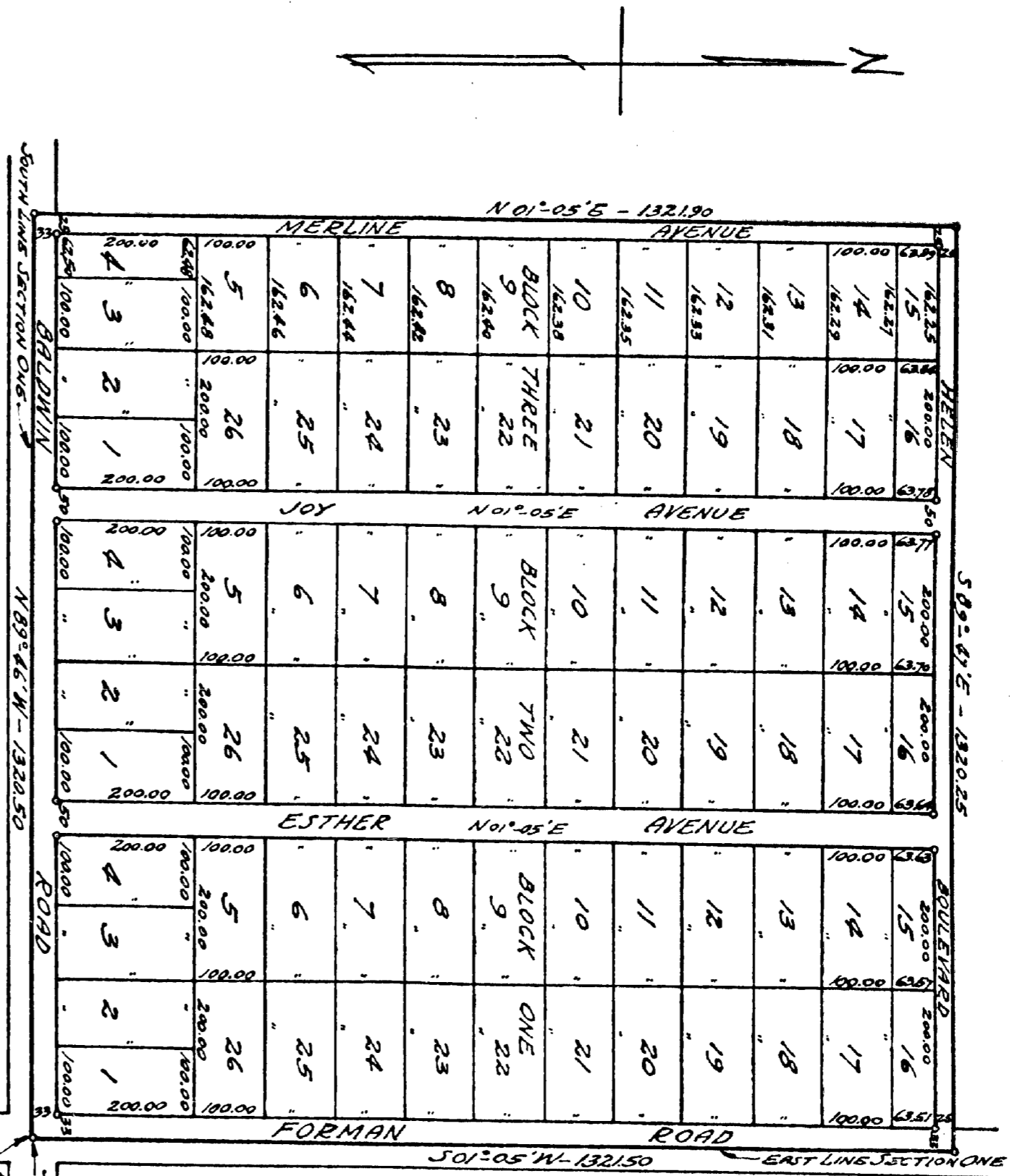


**"THOMPSON'S TERRACE No 2"**

## CERTIFIED COPY OF RESOLUTION To change names of roads

The following resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Lake County Road Commission held on February 19, 1965.

Present: Commissioners Wicks, Kinney, Berzley.

Moved by Commissioner Berzley

supported by Commissioner Kinney

That the following resolution be adopted:

Be it resolved by the Board of County Road Commissioners of Lake County, that the names of certain roads be changed to comply with house numbering system of 800 numbers to the mile and uniformity of names throughout the entire county as follows:

The road on the county line between Lake and Newaygo Counties generally known as Youngs Road and County Line Road be changed to 96 th. Street.

The road running East and West across the county between Townships in T.17 N. and T.18 N. generally known as Neck Road and Hamlin Road be changed to 48 th. Street.

The road running East and West across the county between Townships in T.18 N. and T. 19 N. generally known as Hamilton Road, Thomas Road and Memory Road be changed to Centerline Road.

The road running East and West across the county between Townships in T.19 N. and T.20 N. generally known as Lake Road, Macey Road and Brook Road be changed to 6 Mile Road. The road on the county line between Lake and Haxford-Manistee Counties unnamed be known as 14 Mile Road.

The road running East and West across the county (1) Section North of road between Townships in T.19 N. and T.20 N. generally known as 5 Mile Road, Wheeler Road and Meyers Road be changed to 7 Mile Road.

The road running North and South across the county between Townships in R.12 W. and R.13 W. generally known as Foreman Road and Cherry Road all to be known as Foreman Road.

The road running North and South across the county between Townships in R.13 W. and R.14 W. generally known as Johnson Road and Town Line Road all to be known as Johnson Road.

The road on the county line between Lake and Mason Counties generally known as North Branch Road and Tyndal Road all to be known as North Branch Road.

The road running North and South across the county (2) sections East of road between Townships in R.13 W. and R.14 W. generally known as Peacock Road and 6 Mile Road all to be known as Peacock Road.

The road running North and South across the county (3) Sections East of road between Townships in R.13 W. and R.14 W. generally known as Aster Road and Wolf Lake Road all to be known as Aster Road.

and be it further resolved that within 30 days after adoption of such resolution the Secretary of the Board shall forward to the Auditor General and record with the Register of Deeds of the County of Lake a Certified Copy of same, together with a certificate giving the names of any Plats or subdivisions effected by such resolution."
