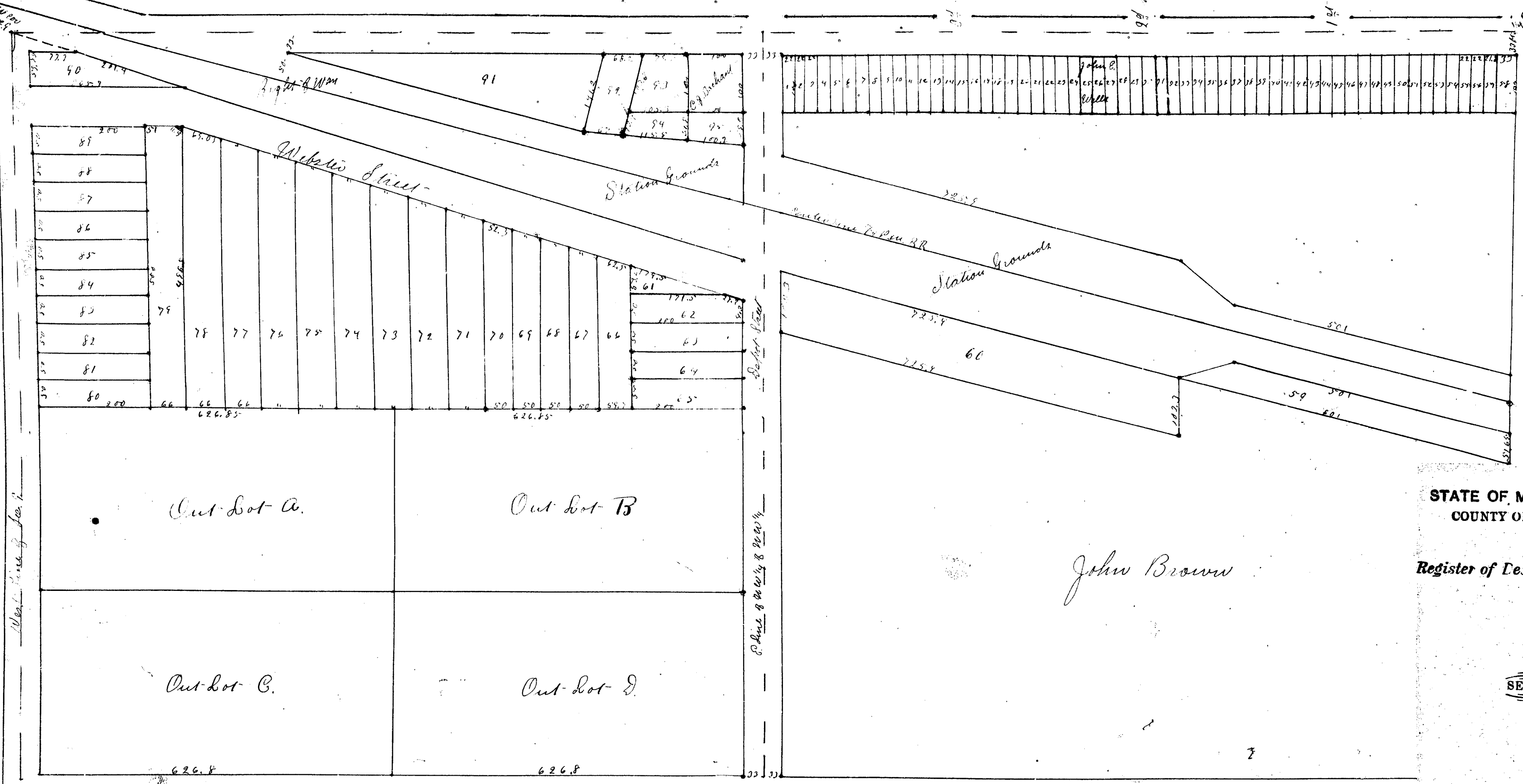

The size of the lots and the width of the streets upon said map are shown in figures, in feet and decimals of a foot. The map is executed in triplicate by Oliver Prescott and William W. Crapo, Trustees, owners, and by Harrison Cary as surveyor for the purpose of being recorded as a town plat in accordance with the Statute. The lands marked "Right of Way" and Station grounds are owned by the Flint and Pere Marquette Rail Road Company. Lands previously conveyed by notes and bonds are platted with the names of the grantee therein. 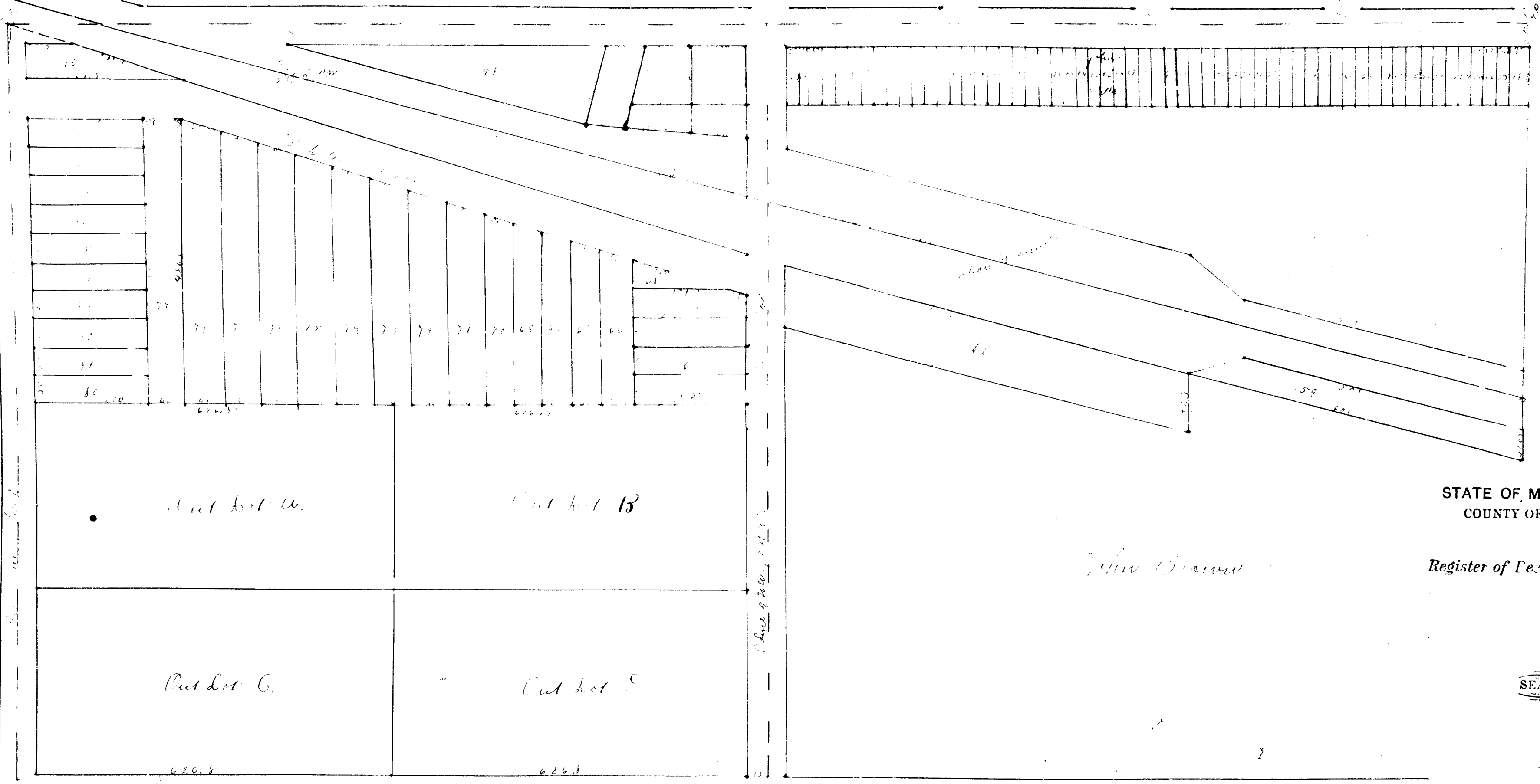
