



## HOUSING COALITION

### OVERVIEW |

The Lake County Housing Coalition (LCHC) exists to develop and manage the Lake County Housing Plan, which provides a framework for providing decent, affordable and diverse housing options for residents of all ages, incomes and household composition in support of a thriving economy and community.

The Lake County Board of Commission will rely on the Lake County Housing Plan to guide housing development and programming support throughout the county.

### MEMBERSHIP |

The LCHC is a voluntary advisory group made up of a diverse membership of housing stakeholders from Lake County organizations and municipalities. It will exist of at least 5 members from organizations serving the housing needs of Lake County. Members will submit a Memorandum of Understanding annually that outlines their commitment as a LCHC member, including serving on at least one subcommittee.

### MEETING SCHEDULE |

The LCHC will meet no less than quarterly to review, revise and implement plan. A report of progress and any recommended updates to the Lake County Housing Plan will also be made to the County Board of Commissioners annually in June, along with a budget recommendation for housing support.

### SUBCOMMITTEES |

Subcommittees will be established focusing on specific areas of housing challenges and solutions, including:

- Blight Elimination and Ordinances
- Unit Development and Developer Attraction
- Housing Education & Programming
